Subject of possible rule making: The agency is amending WAC 314-55-097 and other rules in Title 314 WAC that may be necessary to implement Substitute Senate Bill 5376 (Chapter 243, Laws of 2024) allowing sales of non-hazardous cannabis waste, including allowing sales of cannabis waste to persons who are not cannabis licensees.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: Substitute Senate Bill 5376 (Chapter 243, Laws of 2024), RCW 69.50.342

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Rules on this subject are needed to implement SSB 5376 which will allow licensed cannabis producers and processors to sell non-hazardous solid cannabis waste material from their licensed production or processing operations to buyers who are not licensed by the LCB.
