

Notice of Revised Permanent Rules for Brief Adjudicative Proceedings

This explanatory statement concerns the Washington State Liquor Control Board's adoption of revisions to WAC 314-42-110 Brief adjudicative proceedings and WAC 314-42-115 Preliminary record in brief adjudicative proceedings.

The Administrative Procedure Act (RCW 34.05.325(6)) requires agencies to complete a concise explanatory statement before filing adopted rules with the Office of the Code Reviser. This statement must be provided to anyone who gave comment about the proposed rule making.

Once persons who gave comment during this rule making have had a chance to receive this document, the Liquor Control Board will file the amended rules with the Office of the Code Reviser. These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing (approximately July 5, 2014).
