At a Glance: Guidance for LCB Licensees

Phase 2: LCB licensed business includes:

- Restaurants
- Taverns
- Private clubs
- Caterers for home delivery
- Golf courses
- Snack bars and spas
- Tasting rooms
- Breweries, wineries, and distilleries
- Other “dine-in” venues

Phase 2 Requirements:

- Operate at or below 50% customer capacity
 - No “bar top” seating or service
 - Seating/tables must be “distanced”
 - Tables may seat a maximum of five people, and

Phase 3: Includes Phase 2 businesses. Adds new LCB businesses and events allowed to operate within specific guidelines. Includes:

- Restaurants (can now have up to 75% of customer capacity, tables can seat no more than 10)
- Bar-top seating (up to 25% of the number of customers typically at the bar)
- Caterers for small events (for up to 50 people)
- Movie theaters (up to 50% of customer capacity)
- Nonprofit arts (events limited to 50 people)

- Special occasions (events limited to 50 people)
- Banquet permits (food/events limited to 50 people)

Phase 4: Starts a 30-day withdrawal of the special allowances the LCB made during the COVID-19 shutdowns. Phase 4 also allows for opening:

- Nightclubs
- Sports/entertainment facilities
- Special occasions (expanded events to over 50 people)
